# Upgraded Address Lookup when Adding a New Receiver

## Why it's good

To make entering addresses even easier we have upgraded the address lookup 'auto complete'. Now an even wider range of addresses are available.

## Where to find it

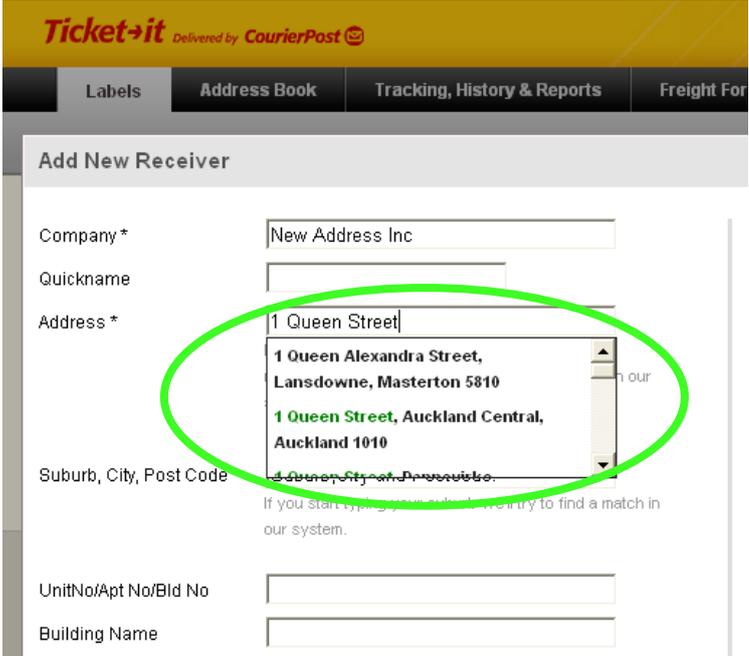
Using the 'Labels' or 'Address Book' tab/screen.

## What's new

We have simplified the way you input addresses when adding a new receiver.

You'll note that there are no longer radio buttons to select a Street Address or PO Box address input. That's because we have simplified things and you can now type in either address type into just the one **Address** field, easy!

Easy address lookup as you start typing now includes even more addresses.
